1	<p>Basic Safety and Health Principles</p> <p>Key principles include identifying hazards, preventing accidents, protecting workers' health and promoting a safety culture at work. Also, the obligations of employers and employees to maintain a safe and healthy working environment are analyzed.</p>	0,5
2	<p>A&Y Legislation and Regulatory Frameworks</p> <p>Focuses on occupational health and safety legislation. The key laws, regulations and standards that apply are covered, such as legislation on the prevention of occupational hazards, employers' obligations, control and inspection procedures, as well as penalties in case of breach of legislation. Also, reference is made to European and international regulatory requirements and how they are applied to Cypriot legislation.</p>	1
3	<p>Basic workplace hazards prevention and management</p> <p>It focuses on the main hazards that can occur in various workplaces, such as mechanical, chemical, biological and ergonomic hazards. It analyzes how these risks can be prevented and managed, through the identification of risks, the assessment of risks, the implementation of preventive measures and the training of employees. Also covered are the fundamentals for formulating an action plan for managing safety and health incidents.</p>	1
4	<p>Emergency</p> <p>Procedures and protocols to be followed in the event of a workplace emergency such as a fire, hazardous material spill, or other emergencies are reviewed. It includes training employees in recognizing and responding to such situations, using appropriate personal protective equipment, and working with specialized emergency response teams. In addition, the way of organizing and carrying out exercises is analyzed.</p>	0,5
